**The Charity Centre for Refugees (CCR) is a non-governmental, non-profit organization founded in 1999 and headquartered in Chișinău, Republic of Moldova. With over 25 years of uninterrupted service, CCR remains one of the country's most experienced actors in the field of asylum and refugee support.**



## Mission and Vision

CCR's mission is to facilitate the pre-integration of asylum seekers and the integration of refugees and beneficiaries of humanitarian protection into Moldovan society. We pursue this by promoting community-based activities, supporting self-reliance through employment, and raising awareness around the realities and contributions of displaced persons.

Our vision is of an inclusive world where those seeking refuge and the communities receiving them cooperate to build better lives for all — united by a shared sense of humanity, dignity, and hope.



## Whom We Serve

CCR supports a wide range of vulnerable groups, including:

- Asylum seekers and refugees
- Beneficiaries of humanitarian protection
- Stateless persons and third-country nationals affected by displacement (notably from Ukraine)
- Vulnerable Moldovan citizens, especially women, children, the elderly, and persons with disabilities
- Survivors of violence, including victims of trafficking and gender-based violence

## Our Areas of Work

- Education: Access to formal and non-formal education for refugee children, afterschool activities, and digital inclusion

## HUMANITARIAN CONTEXT OF 2024

In 2024, Moldova remained a key humanitarian hub in Eastern Europe, responding to the prolonged Ukrainian refugee crisis and new displacement triggered by conflicts in the Gaza Strip and across the Middle East and Asia.



Over 127,000 Ukrainian refugees remained in Moldova by year-end (UNHCR), and more than 2,540 individuals from various countries were registered as refugees and asylum seekers (IGM).

This influx stretched Moldova's social fabric, from education and healthcare to housing and livelihoods. Importantly, local communities demonstrated remarkable solidarity, highlighting Moldova's openness and resilience in integrating newcomers.

Amid this backdrop, the Charity Centre for Refugees (CCR) stood out as one of the key partners—not only for UNHCR and international stakeholders, but also for government institutions. CCR's work extended beyond supporting Ukrainian refugees: it provided protection, assistance, and integration services to refugees and asylum seekers from around the world. By promoting access to education, healthcare, psychosocial support, and livelihoods, CCR contributed significantly to social cohesion, showcasing refugees' positive contributions to their communities.

Even as global instability persisted, CCR reaffirmed its commitment: ensuring every refugee in Moldova finds a safe, supportive environment—one in which they can rebuild their lives, participate fully, and enrich their new communities.




